



By attending Camperfest 2011 you agree to abide by the rules and regulations below.

1. Camperfest 2011 will not accept responsibility for any loss of belongings, damage to property or injury on site at the festival.
2. Dogs are allowed on site, but not in the Food, Drink and Lifestyle Festival, children's rides area or Beer Fest. All dogs must be kept on a lead and you must clear up all fouling.
3. Only raised BBQ's are permitted and should not be placed directly on the ground.
4. Toilet and shower facilities are provided on site.
5. A wristband will be given to each camper on arrival to Camperfest and must be worn through out the festival at all times.
6. The information desk at the front of the racecourse will be open from 9am – 5.30pm.
7. No person under the age of 18 is permitted to stay on site un-supervised. Parents are responsible for the behavior and safety of their children at all times.
8. Pitches will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
9. You must keep within your pitch, leaving a 5m gap between pitches for campervans and caravans. You will be asked to move specific objects if they are obstructing and therefore breaking this rule.
10. Use of generators, petrol or diesel is not permitted.
11. Rubbish should be put in the black sacks provided in your welcome pack and the sacks should be placed in skips provided.
12. You are asked not to make unreasonable noise, especially after 10pm. One warning will be given if this occurs, after this Camperfest may terminate the tenancy without warning and at once. If this rule is applied, no payment will be refunded.
13. Smoking is not permitted in enclosed areas including marquees and trade areas.
14. You must have a suitable fire extinguisher, at least 900g of powder. It is also strongly recommended that a fire blanket is available in the cooking area.
15. Open fires are not permitted.
16. No one is permitted to sleep in a car.
17. Please familiarise yourself with the nearest fire point to your van to avoid confusion in an emergency.
18. If a fire occurs, make nearby vans aware and call the fire brigade on (999) as well as the Camperfest team at the Camperfest Hub.
19. The ticket allows you entry to all sections of the weekend including Chester Food, Drink and Lifestyle Festival and Beer Fest, apart from the Saturday night which will cost £5.00 per person. It will also give you entry to the Camperfest welcome and Leaving party.
20. At no point must any one camp or use the restricted areas.
21. Due to the nature of the site no one must dig holes within the site.
22. The main gate will close at 11.30pm from Chester City center.



23. Illicit drugs and excessive use of alcohol is not permitted.
24. The Camperfest team makes the final decision on all matters during the festival.
25. In the unlikely event, that because of matters outside our control, Chester Race Company Ltd, deems the area unfit for habitation, the event will be cancelled and a full refund of any monies paid to us by the booker, made to all Camperfest bookings. No other payment will be made by the company. We accept your booking under these conditions.
